What is the same about each of these things?



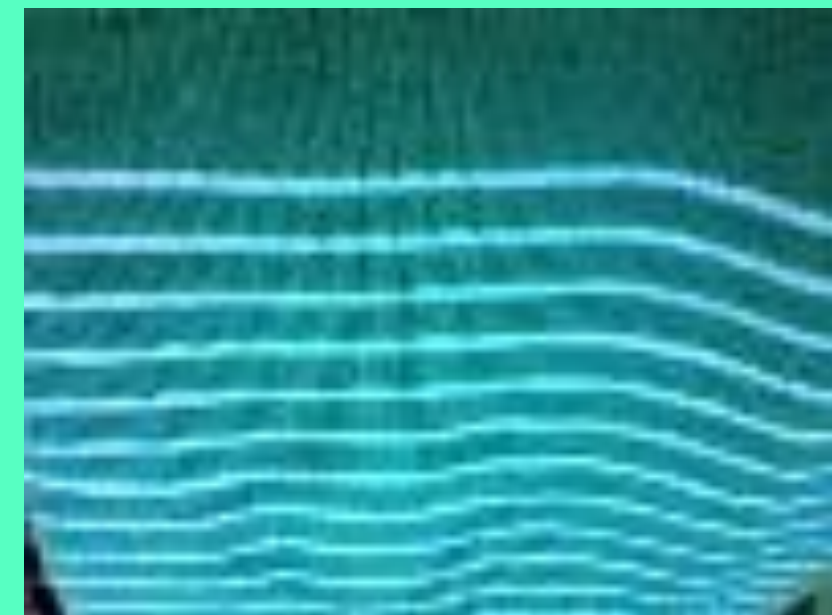
The door, the flower, and the fire engine are all red!

bench, and a couch?

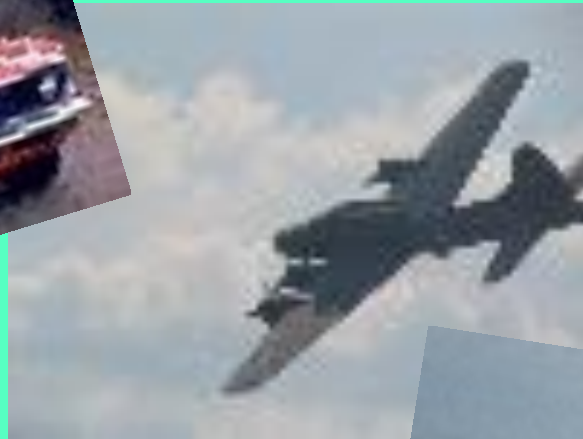
They are all things you wear!
